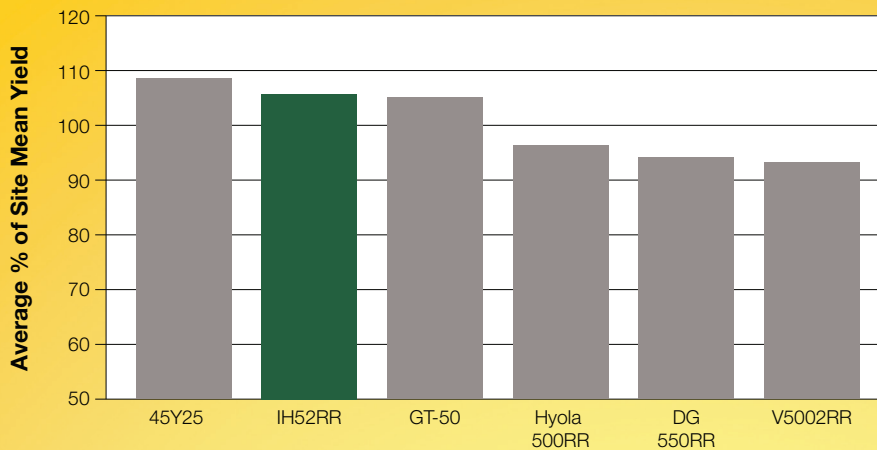

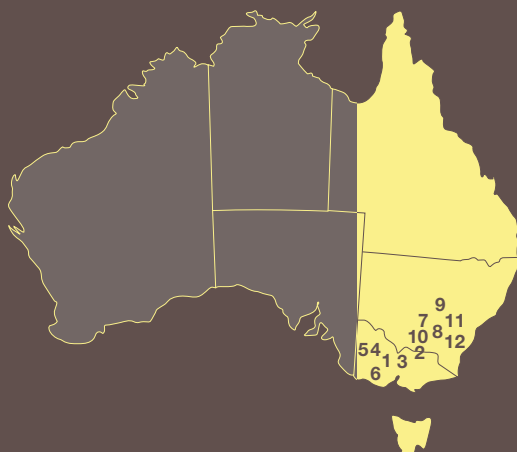


Data compiled from 12 NVT sites in 2014 where all 5-series varieties listed were present.
